Khedkar Marg, CIDCO,N-6, Aurangabad- 431003, Maharashtra for continuing BHMS course with intake of 100 seats for the academic year 2024-2025-regarding.

Sir,

Shri Bhagwan Homoeopathic Medical College and Indira Gandhi Memorial Hospital, Maharashtra is functional since 1986 has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with 100 seats for the academic year 2024-25. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the Part 1 information the following observations are to be taken care for better performance of college and hospital.

1. Miscellaneous

- Adhaar enabled biometric attendance system (AEBAS) is not implemented. This may be enabled within a period of one month.
- Attendance & acquittance of teaching faculty is not legible. Copy of attendance register & acquittance of teaching faculty for the last 3 months may be provided for verification.
- Acquittance and attendance of guest faculty is not uploaded. College shall submit the acquittance and attendance of last 3 months
- Attendance and acquittance of modern medicine consultant is not uploaded. College shall submit the copy of attendance and acquittance of modern medicine consultants for last 3 months for verification.

IPD and OPD case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as Name, Age, Sex, Address, Phone number, etc. Diagnosis of the case shall be recorded as per ICD 11 criteria. All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records. Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case history, analysis and evaluation and repertorisation and made available in Medical Record Room for academic purpose of students and follow up of patients.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional permission to Shri Bhagwan Homoeopathic Medical College and Indira Gandhi Memorial Hospital, Dr. Y.S. Khedkar Marg, CIDCO,N-6, Aurangabad- 431003, Maharashtra for continuing BHMS course with intake of 100 seats for the academic year 2024-2025.**

All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

It is further to mention that all admissions shall be made for NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority of State/UT Govt. as designated by Central Government for the A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT.

The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college can be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.

(v) **Deficiencies observed by NCH** : The shortcomings mentioned in paragraph No. II (1) and requirements as per paragraph No. III of the NCH, New Delhi letter referred above may please be fulfilled and the compliance letter to be forwarded directly to NCH, New Delhi and copy of the same shall be forwarded to the University within a period of 30 days.

Important Note:

- 1) This Conditional Continuation / Extension of affiliation is issued for the A.Y. 2024-2025 subject to the permission of NCH / Govt. of India / Department of AYUSH, New Delhi. Further, if the permission is declined by the said authorities, this Conditional Continuation / Extension of Affiliation shall be treated as cancelled. The College is not authorized to admit the students for 1st Year of the course until receipt of permission of the NCH / Govt. of India/ Department of AYUSH New Delhi.
- 2) The admission shall be done through the Competent Authorities only.
